As many of the members are aware, the whole world is out of sprayer equipment right now and people are resorting to jerry-rigging their own or using something that may not be all that affordable, convenient or effective.

We can help! We have inked a distribution agreement with a prominent manufacturer of industrial-quality spray equipment and are pleased to announce that we're awaiting our first shipment of an awesome rechargeable sprayer we've christened the MobiMIST[™].



Powered by a strong lithium ion battery, this sprayer holds a whopping 5 gallons of solution and features easy-roll 8" wheels, so you won't have to lug it around and tire out your shoulder. The coiled hose makes spraying convenient without having a giant hose laying on the floor. The sprayer can be used close up, but is also powerful enough to shoot solution 25' laterally and 12' vertically.

The tank has markings in gallons & liters so there's no guesswork involved. Fill to the proper line, then just drop in the appropriate number of tablets to yield just the right strength and quantity of hypochlorous acid you need.
