



Dear Ready-To-Use (RTU) Doodoo Voodoo Customer,

Hello, and thanks for your order of Doodoo Voodoo and our related products. We appreciate your purchase, which helps us provide assistance to needy animals, as we've been doing since 1983 via our multiple licensed charities, our charitable foundation, our nonprofit spay/neuter clinic and the private rescue facility where we provide lifelong care for special-needs animals. Your purchase helps these animals and many more, so thank you for your support.

You've purchased our Gallon RTU (ready-to-use) offering, which means that once you combine the SUPER Concentrate with tap water, it will be ready to use right out of the bottle and you won't have to dilute it further before use. If your problems are on carpet or upholstery and are severe, I recommend that you use the product full-strength. If, however, you feel that your issues are less severe — say below a 5 on a scale of 1-10, or if your issues are on hard surfaces such as hardwood and vinyl, or if you're doing routine cleaning, or if you're doing subsurface extraction (see our website for more about this awesome, easy and totally effective procedure, which you can perform for as little as \$39.99) — you might be able to dilute your RTU Doodoo Voodoo further. SUPER Concentrates dilutes from 1/4oz to 1oz per quart using the included measuring cup. (By comparison, regular Concentrate dilutes at 1/2oz to 2oz per quart.)

If you're treating urine on tile and grout, you probably should stick with the strongest (1oz SUPER Concentrate per quart) ratio. Grout is notoriously porous and it can be difficult to eradicate odors in, so I don't recommend diluting your RTU.

When considering whether to dilute your RTU Doodoo Voodoo or not, be aware that once you dilute it, you can't reverse the process and go back to a stronger mixture. If you want to try a more-diluted blend, but think you might want to make some stronger later, you can with the included measuring cup. Just be sure to label your bottle with a piece of tape or marking pen so you know what dilution the bottle contains.

Speaking of containers, we don't want unlabeled Doodoo Voodoo floating around, so we've included an extra label for you to put on your bottle. If you fill more than one spray bottle, be sure to download the label file on our site's [DOWNLOADS](#) page or at least write on the bottle with a permanent marker so you and others know what's in the bottle.

Just so you're not confused by my recommendations above about diluting your Doodoo Voodoo, I should mention that customers have been using RTU Doodoo Voodoo as-is (full-strength) for decades and loving it! As such, I am not telling you that you *have* to dilute your RTU further; only that you *can* if you deem your issues to be less severe, or they're on hard surfaces, or if you're doing routine cleaning or subsurface extraction. I'm just trying to help you use Doodoo Voodoo in the most appropriate and efficient manner, and to help you extend your Doodoo Voodoo value when it's appropriate to do so. Sorry if the dilution thing is confusing, but you'll quickly get the hang of it.

We know you'll be pleased with Doodoo Voodoo's performance as so many thousands of others have been over the decades. Once you've gotten your feet wet with RTU, we hope that you'll then consider purchasing one of our Concentrate kits, which allow you tons of application flexibility and reduce the per-quart price of Doodoo Voodoo even further.
